

## **GUIDELINES for SFRR-EUROPE EARLY CAREER INVESTIGATOR TRAVEL AWARDS 2017**

**Two SFRR-Europe Early Career Investigator Travel Awards for 2017 -€2000** each one- are sponsored by **Elsevier** on behalf of **FRBM** and **Redox Biology**, respectively and will be awarded to Early Career Investigators to cover travel and accommodation expenses during a short research stay in another laboratory in Europe. Applicants should submit a single PDF containing a brief summary of the research project (maximum one A4 page) stating the expected duration and rationale for the short stay, CV (maximum 2 A4 pages) including a list of publications, and abbreviated CVs (maximum 2 A4 pages) of supervisors at their home and host institutions. Applications should be submitted as a single PDF file, using the online system for this SFRR-Europe call for applications for the **SFRR-E EARLY CAREER INVESTIGATOR TRAVEL AWARDS 2017**, which is available at <https://www.sfr-europe.org/>.

The deadline for applications is **20 May 2017**, and applicants will be notified during the joint SFRR-E/OCC Meeting 2017.

### **Requirements for the applicant:**

- Under 35 years of age and without a permanent university position
- Member of SFRR-Europe
- Submission of an up-to-date focused REVIEW article to FRBM or Redox Biology 6 months after visit
- Presentation of a brief report to the SFRR-Europe Executive at annual meeting and online on the SFRR-Europe website

### **Requirements for the supervisors at the home and host institutions:**

- Member of SFRR-Europe
