The community for free radical research first came together in the UK in 1982, and then expanded to include international colleagues as the Society for Free Radical Research. Building on strong research in the redox and free radical areas, it grew quickly and by 1988 daughter societies in different geographic areas were established, including SFRR-Europe.

The aim of SFRR-Europe is to support research in the redox biology, free radical and antioxidant fields, enabling scientists in these areas to interact and develop research from basic science to translational applications. It is especially focused on enhancing the development of early career researchers and introducing them to the established community. SFRR-Europe is now well-established with annual conferences, awards for young scientists and established investigators, and funding for travel, conference attendance and research stays at other labs.
